### Pastor Mark's Blog

I was struck last Sabbath at the Daniel Seminar how Daniel 4 is basically a testimony written in a letter from Nebuchadnezzar, the King of Babylon, to his vast empire. It is honest and gives the glory to God for what He had done in the life of the King. Nebuchadnezzar was not perfect, far from it, but he got there in the end. He made his decision for the Lord and gave a public testimony about it.

Nebuchadnezzar concludes his letter with the words,

*“Now I, Nebuchadnezzar, praise and extol and honour the King of heaven, all of whose works are truth, and His ways justice. And those who walk in pride He is able to put down.” (The New King James Version. (1982). (Da 4:37)).*

Even in his final sentence of the letter Nebuchadnezzar is honest about his struggle with pride and how the Lord has graciously dealt with him to bring him down, so as to lift him up into a relationship with a glorious eternal future.
