Our Week of Prayer's final reading concludes with "Ellen White was aware that her message consisted of applying the biblical message to God's people at the end of time. Above all, she was clear that her testimonies were "a lesser light," destined to lead the people to the "greater light" of the Scriptures. She assumed that her messages were subject to the canonical authority of the Scriptures, so she invited her listeners and readers to study the Bible and to put her message into practice. Speaking to the assembly during her last General Conference session in 1909, she held up her Bible before the delegates and said, "Brethren and sisters, I commend unto you this Book." The best way that we twenty-first-century Seventh-day Adventists can honour Ellen White's legacy is to continue to be known as "the people of the Book," a people who love Jesus and exalt the Bible as the standard of faith and practice."
