Today as part of our sermon series on the Psalms, we will look at Psalm 3. It is a Psalm of King David. It reflects a deeply broken relationship between a Father and a Son. It is one of the Psalms where we can have some certainty about when it was written during David's life, given the scribal comment at the start of the Psalm. The circumstances are found in 2 Samuel 15.

David concludes Psalm 3 with "Salvation belongs to the LORD. Your blessing is upon Your people.". It has been shown that healthy relationships can help heal past wounds. Salvation means to heal!
